

Robert B. Anderson is a Professor with the Faculty of Business Administration of the University of Regina. Prior to joining the faculty, Bob spent ten years with the First Nations University of Canada. He has a Ph.D. in regional economic development (geography). Bob also has an MBA and is a Certified Management Accountant. He has authored numerous peer-reviewed papers and made many conference presentations on economic development and entrepreneurship.
